Topic Sentences

No matter how many body paragraphs an essay has, it is essential that each contain a **topic sentence**. A topic sentence provides direction for the structure and flow of the paragraph and also keeps the reader's mind focused on the direct purpose of the paragraph, and the essay as a whole.
