

## Mock Facebook Assignment

### **Deadline: Monday, 9/12/16 @ beginning of class**

Purpose: The purpose of this assignment is for you to consider your life so far like you would history. What are the major events in your historical timeline that brought you to where you are today (physically, academically, etc.)? How do you trace your path across the world map (e.g., where have you lived and/or travelled AND how has this influenced your story and where you are today? Where do you plan to be and what do you plan to accomplish one year from now? Five years from now?

Also, there is the added bonus that I get to know you better by knowing your history.

Your task: Create a “mock” or imitation Facebook page suitable for my eyes. Your Facebook page will not be shared with your classmates. Include the following:

- Your historical timeline of important events that have brought you to where you are today. Include 4-6 events.
- A map of your story (lived, traveled to, want to go to, etc.) that connects these locations with who you are, what brought you to where you are, and what you plan to achieve in your lifetime. Include these connections in a caption near your map.
- An about you section that includes where you’re from and your birthday
- A status update about anything you think represents you, your personality, your goals, etc.
- Pictures: profile picture, cover photo, and any other images that fit you and your story. You must have a minimum 2 pictures.

Rubric: You will be graded on this assignment as follows:

2 = complete

1 = partially complete

0 = not completed

Notes:

- So long as your real Fb page doesn’t contain any explicit or private information that you wouldn’t want revealed to me you can simply print your profile page on Fb and turn it in (make sure it has all of the required items). Otherwise, put everything on a Microsoft PowerPoint, Word, or Publisher document and print it from there.
- If you don’t have access to a computer at home, you may use a school computer in the library. Open after school M-Th.
- If you are unsure how to create your mock Facebook page, use mine as an example (posted to website).
